Do you love robotics, like flying drones, play the ukulele, or have another passion you would like to share with children age 8-14? Do you want to support our local Hudson Valley students while at the same time earning professional development and a pay check? The CONNECT After-School Program helps youth reach their full potential in school and life. CONNECT Teachers are needed to provide exciting extracurricular enrichment courses to students grades 3-8 and help instill beneficial skill sets to help students learn, create, excel, and lead in STEM and the humanities. Teachers are needed from 3-5 p.m. Tuesday & Thursday, Monday & Wednesday, or once a month on Fridays. CONNECT services the Highland Falls Intermediate School in Highland Falls, New York. The first CONNECT after school session runs from September 6 through December 9. Salary is commensurate with skills and experience.

Transportation is available and provided to and from the Highland Falls Intermediate School for free from the Mount Saint Mary College campus.

To apply applicants should submit their resume to include their G.P.A. with a brief description of the course and its duration (Monday & Wednesday or Tuesday & Thursday, or once a month on a scheduled Friday).
