



The Teddy Forstmann Scholarship Program was established in 2012 in honor of CSF's late co-founder. Teddy Forstmann scholarships are available at [CSF Participating Private Schools](#) in the five boroughs of New York City.

To be eligible for a new Teddy Forstmann scholarship, children must be entering Kindergarten for the first time in September OR entering grades 1 – 8 and transferring from a public school. Families must meet the income guidelines below and register their students at a CSF-participating school.

- Please note that scholarship amounts vary depending on the family's income, household size, and the school's tuition cost. In 2025-26, the average CSF scholarship in New York City is **\$2,757.00**
- CSF scholarships **do not** cover the full tuition. Families are required to pay the difference between the school tuition and the scholarship. Families will also have to pay any additional school fees.
- Families are expected to contribute a minimum of 25 percent of their children's tuition.
