





Once you click on "pending forms", it should bring you to a "My Forms" page.

Click on the "Covid Immunization and Booster History" form

Not required by Health Services, but may be required for your major

- ← Fill out the information based on the type of vaccine you received for doses #1, #2 and your booster dose (Jansen/J & J, Pfizer, Moderna).
- ← Upload a picture of your COVID vaccine card by clicking on "select file". You must fill out the requested information AND upload your COVID vaccine card picture, then click "submit" to complete this step.



Click on the "Health History & Immunization form" link. Make sure to fill out all boxes.

- ← Upload a picture of your immunization dates that you should have received from your own provider (this will have the dates, lot number and vaccine names you were given in your provider's office), by clicking on "select file" tab next to "Please upload an image of your immunization history as provided by your doctor."
- ← Upload your recent physical on this page as well by clicking on the "select file" tab next to "Attention full time students enrolled in 12 credits or more, please upload a copy of your current physical (within the last 12 months) from your primary care provider" to upload your form from your provider.
- ← Once you have filled out all boxes and uploaded your immunization records and recent physical, click on "submit".
- ← If you do not fill in the boxes on this page, do not upload a picture of your immunization records and/ or do not upload your most recent physical exam (within the past year), your forms are not complete.
- You must click on "submit" or your forms and information will not be saved.

Health Records/Immunization information is due August 1. We prefer students to submit it prior to arriving on campus for orientation. Please follow directions for submission of health records/immunization requirements as noted for the msmary.studenthealthportal.com
